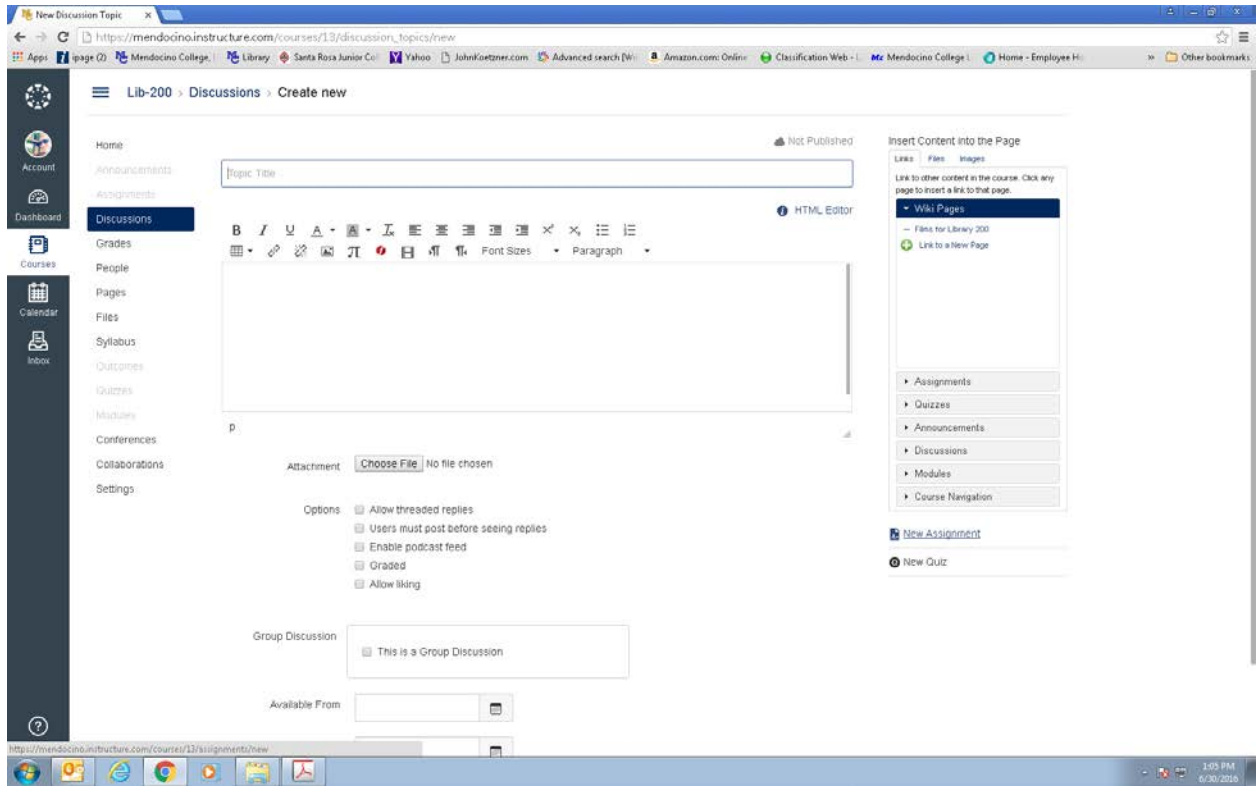
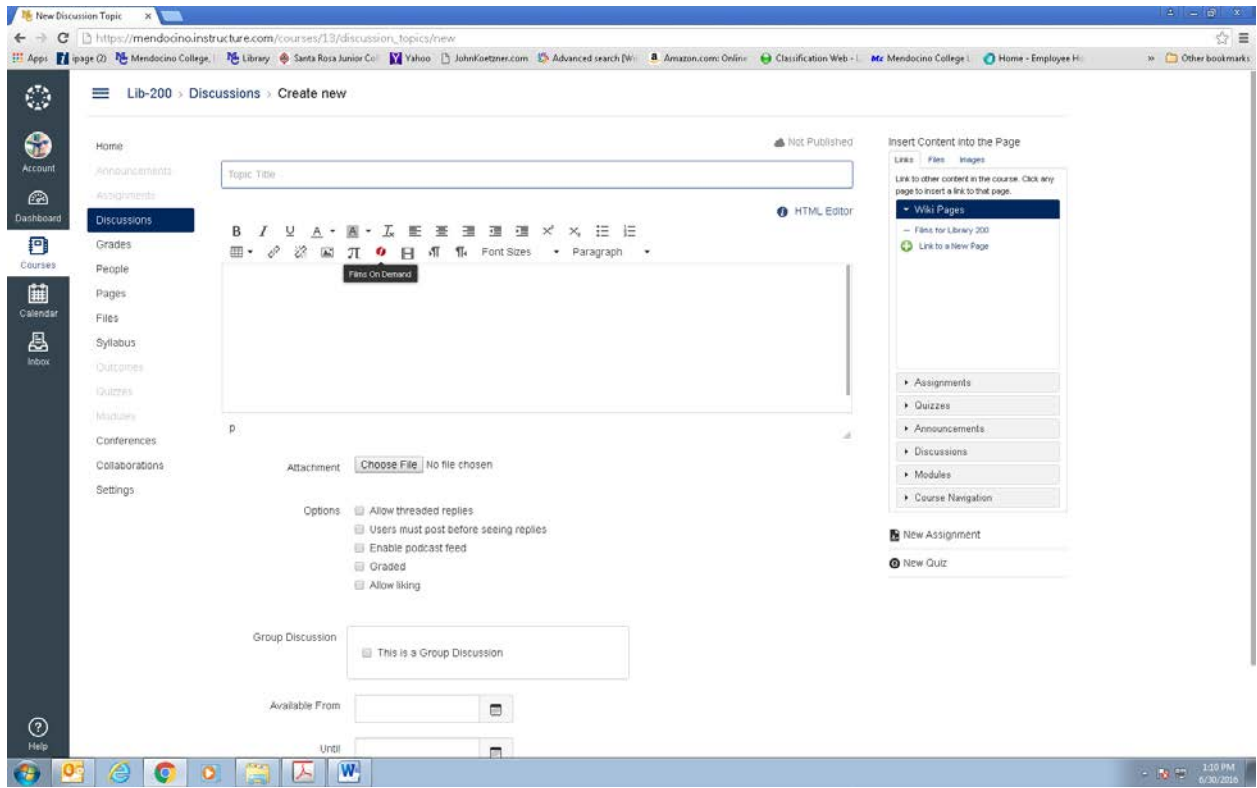


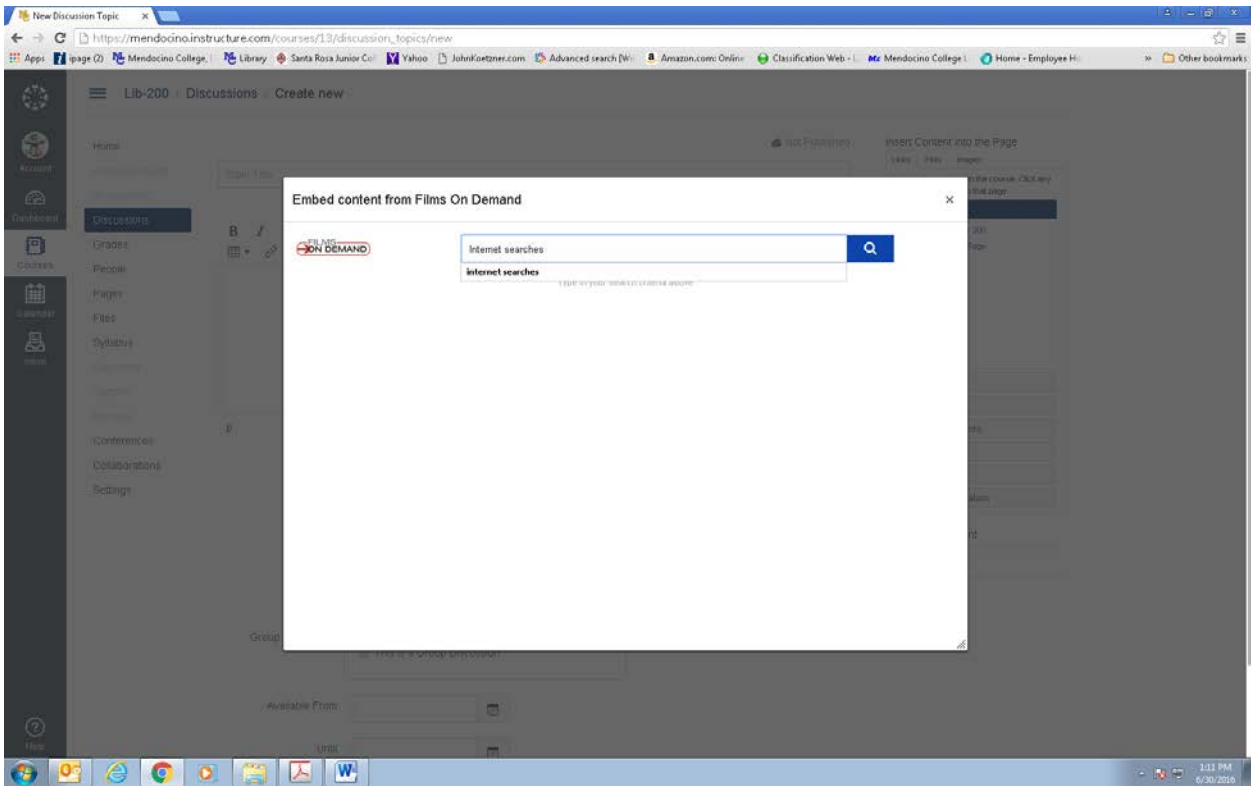
Canvas allows you to embed streaming videos from Mendocino College's collection of nearly 25,000 streaming video titles in **Films on Demand**. You can either embed full videos or clips from within films.



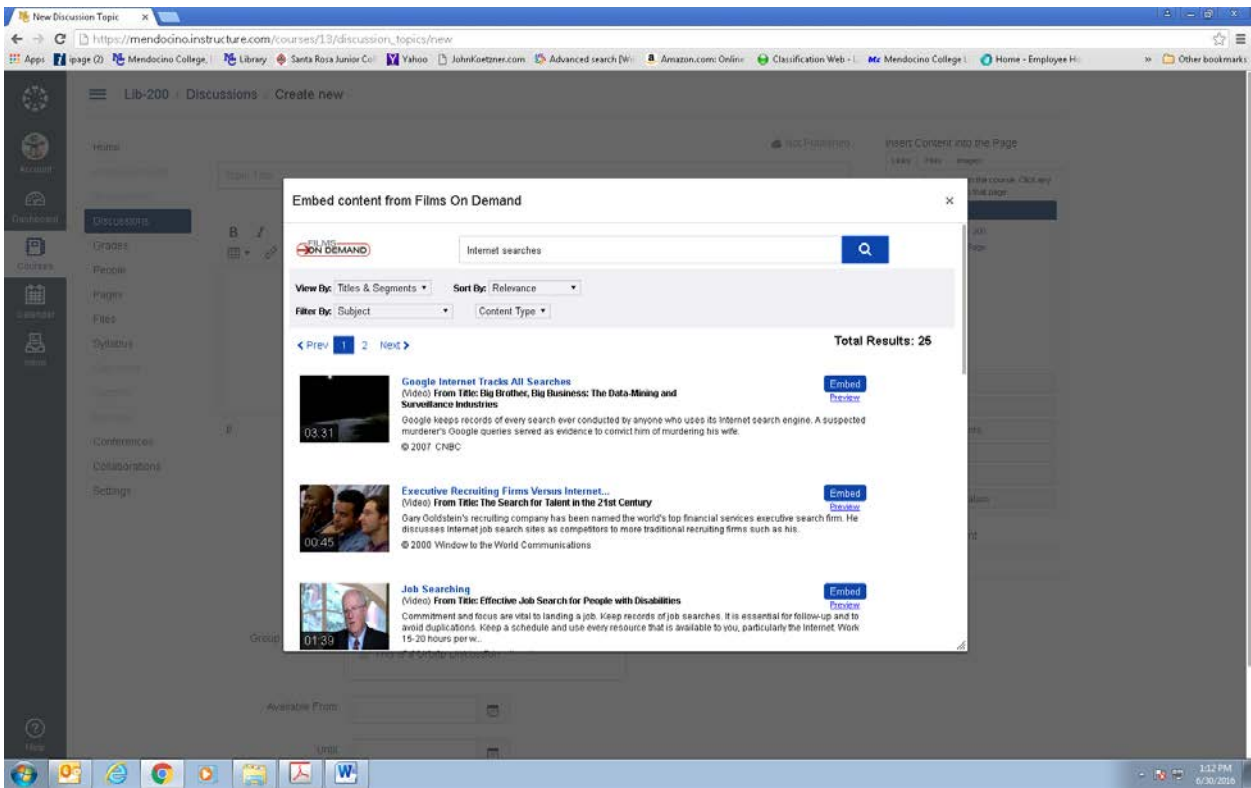
Click on the Films on Demand icon (white f in a red circle background) in the toolbar to launch a search.



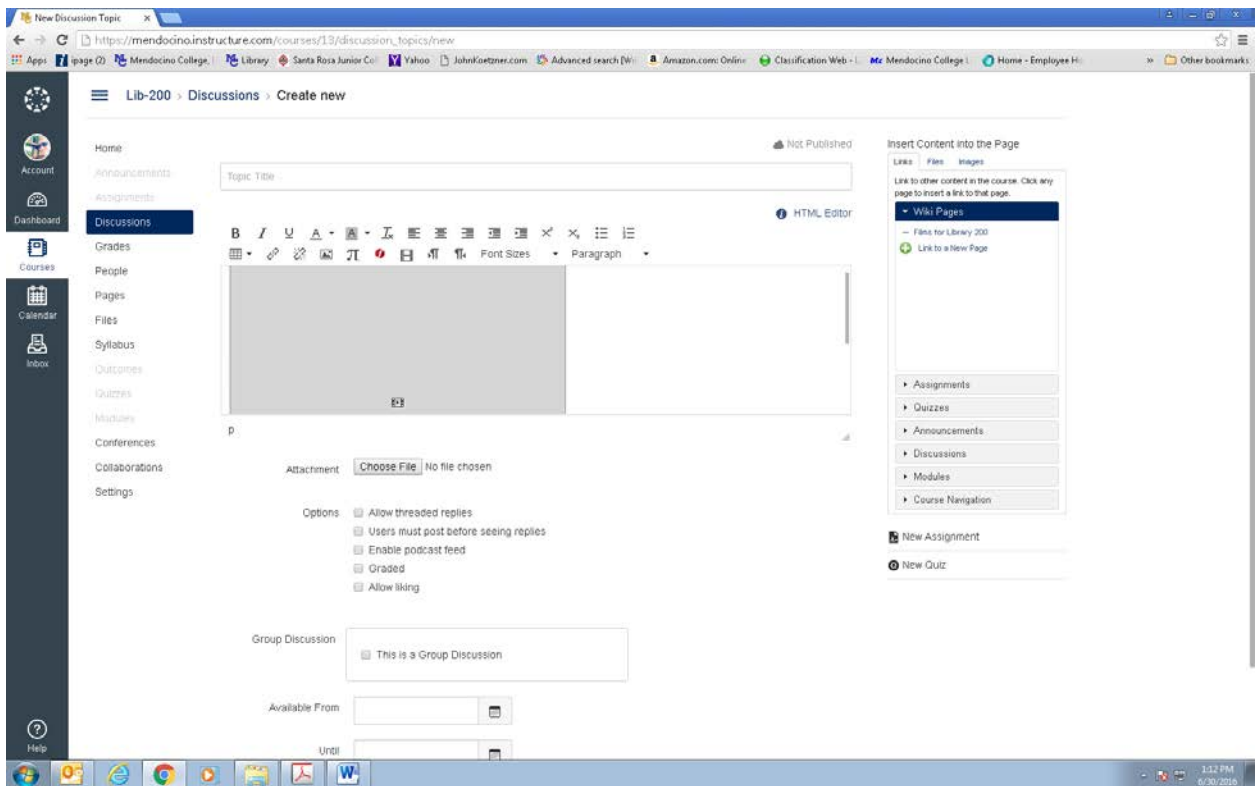
Once the search screen shows up, you can use different terms to conduct your searches. In the search below, I did Internet searches.



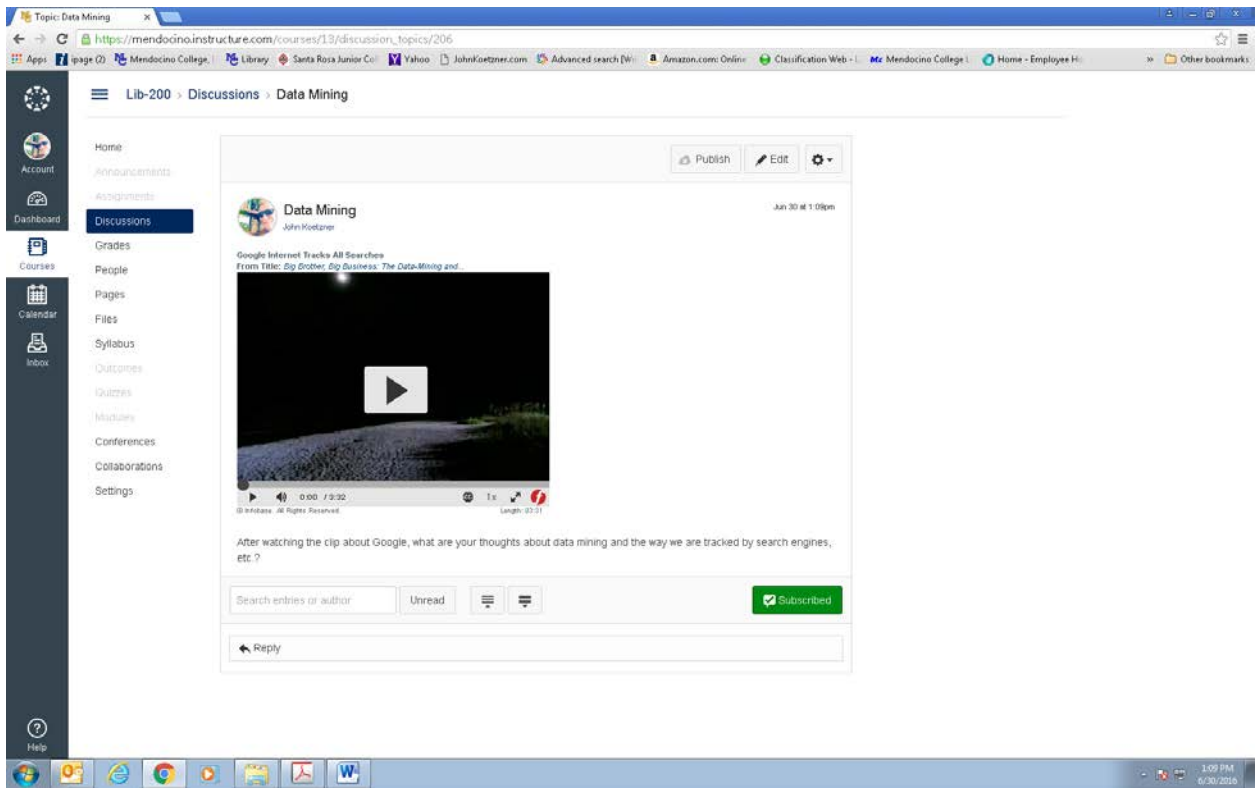
The results pop up, and if I like a film, I can actually embed it by hitting the blue embed button at the right of the search results.



Once you click on the blue embed button, the screen will load the video, which will then look like the screen below.



Once you save the page, you will see the embedded video that is ready to launch. Students **do not** have to log into Films on Demand... It is automatically authenticated from within Canvas.



The icon for Films on Demand (the white f in the red circle background) is available on the toolbar for the **Announcements, Assignments, Discussions, and Pages** areas within the Canvas learning environment. This means you can create assignments, announcements, discussions, and pages of videos to embed in your course and use them in a variety of ways.
